Geoffrey Robert Little

On behalf of Western's Board of Governors, President Alan Shepard, and the Senate Librarian Selection Committee, I am very pleased to share that **Geoffrey Robert Little** has accepted a five-year term as Vice-Provost and Chief Librarian, effective July 22, 2024.

Geoffrey comes to Western from Concordia University where he has held a series of leadership positions since 2010, including his current position of Associate University Librarian for Scholarly Communication. Prior to his service at Concordia, Geoffrey managed public affairs and outreach for one of the largest academic libraries in the world at Yale University (2007-2010). Geoffrey will bring to Western his considerable experience with public services planning and delivery, project and information technology management, collection stewardship, donor engagement, and consensus-building leadership in an academic library environment.

Among his accomplishments at Concordia, Geoffrey played a pivotal role in the creation and launch of Concordia University Press, a non-profit scholarly publisher with a strong commitment to equity and accessibility. He also led the development of a multi-phase digital preservation service as well as the implementation of ORCID across the university.

An active and engaged researcher within academic librarianship, Geoffrey has published and presented widely, receiving grants and awards from organizations and funding bodies including SSHRC. In 2023 he was the Patricia Fleming Fellow in Bibliography and Book History at the University of Toronto and a Visiting Scholar at Massey College.

Geoffrey holds a Master of Arts in History from Concordia (2015) and a Master of Information Studies from University of Toronto (2007). He will maintain his rank of Senior Librarian upon his arrival at Western.
